

Enrollment SOP

FS Courses, Enrollment Queries:

Currently providers deploying within 90 days and providers who will serve as the sole flight surgeon for the entire state are priority over all other attendees. Seats are not normally available to individuals who are not reporting to a deploying Unit within 90 days. You must contact your training officer in order to receive a seat in a class, as USASAM does not have the ability to add students into ATTRS. For applicants without a training officer, the POCs listed below can put you in touch with the appropriate ATTRS seat manager for further assistance. Non OBC graduates are not permitted to attend our course. Applicants for initial flight surgeon training who are unable to secure a stamped qualified flight physical in AERO (electronic physical exam system) within 30 days of the start of classes will be disenrolled in order to accommodate physically qualified deploying students. Arrivals to the course who have not secured an ATTRS seat and/or who are not physically qualified will be directed return to home Unit at Unit/personal expense. Applicants with questions about physical qualification status (for those unable to confirm status through a flight surgeon) and applicants who require a flight surgeon to enter a physical into AERO, should contact AAMA, 334-244-0750 or 334-255-0749. All questions about physical exams should be addressed to AAMA. The FDME link on our website lists all requirements. Flight surgeons less than 5 years from last flight assignment and/or initial training are not eligible for the refresher orientation course; distance learning is available at <http://usasam.amedd.army.mil/dl/FSR.htm>
