1. The following AMEDD Reserve and National Guard Packet Requirement Checklists are effective per the date indicated.

It is critical that packets be received at the RAMC at MEDCOM in the amount of days prior as indicated on the specific packet requirements checklist. 3. These checklists are provided so you clearly understand the DA process requirements. Once completed, it must be submitted through your chain of command for verification, approval and support before submission to the RAMC for review.
