PRIORITY LIST FOR THE INSTRUCTOR TRAINING COURSE (ITC)


1. **HISTORY.** This is the first printing of this publication and supersedes Academy of Health Sciences Policy #32, 29 Jan 01.
2. **PURPOSE.** To establish priorities for enrollment in the ITC.
3. **REFERENCE.** U.S. Army Training and Doctrine Command Regulation 350-70, Systems Approach to Training Management, Processes, and Products. (Related)
4. **GENERAL.** Instructor candidates will be enrolled in the ITC based upon the following priorities:
  - a. Personnel from the U.S. Army Medical Department Center and School (AMEDDC&S) who are assigned to authorized instructor positions on the Table of Distribution and Allowances and whose primary duty is teaching.
  - b. Drill Instructors who are required to possess the "H" Additional Skill Identifier.
  - c. Phase 2, AMEDDC&S-numbered course site instructors.
  - d. U.S. Army Reserve/Army National Guard allocated quotas
  - e. Selected personnel recommended by department chiefs.
  - f. Brooke Army Medical Center Nursing Education/Training non-Phase 2 personnel.
  - g. Others, on a space-available basis, once AMEDDC&S priorities have been exhausted.
5. When necessary, a standby list of personnel ready to attend the course will be employed. The list will be prioritized as stated above.
