**My Position:** Serves as the Dean for the US Army School of Aviation Medicine (USASAM); Academy of Health Sciences; AMEDD Center and School, directing activities in seven departments in support of Army transformation.

**My Skills:** COL Smalley attended medical school at Ohio University's School of Osteopathic Medicine. He is board certified by the American Board of Osteopathic Preventive Medicine and is a Certified Physician Executive. Since his commissioning, he has held leadership positions in both AMEDD and Divisional Units including the 101<sup>st</sup> Airborne Division. He is a graduate of Air Assault and Airborne schools and earned his Expert Field Medical Badge, Gold German Armed Forces Badge for Military Proficiency, and his Master Flight Surgeon Wings.
