

# Requirements for 7R and 7S ASI

---

Code: 7R

Title: Hospital Ministries

Proponent: CCH

- a. Description of positions. Identifies positions which require advanced pastoral skills in ministry in a hospital setting (except in Combat Stress Control Medical Company must use SI 7S) and in Military Police Internment/Resettlement Battalions.
  - b. Qualifications. Requires completion of at least one advanced unit or post-graduate level clinical pastoral training equivalent in a hospital setting and completion of 1 year satisfactory service in an identified position.
  - c. Restrictions. For use with AOC 56A only. Application must be made through the supervisory chaplain by the end of the second year of the utilization or upon reassignment if less than 2 years.

Code: 7S

Title: Combat Medical Pastoral Care Specialist

Proponent: CCH

- a. Description of positions. Identifies positions requiring specialized ministry in a battle field healthcare environment as part of a healthcare team
  - b. Qualifications. Requires completion of one unit of Clinical Pastoral Education (CPE) from any Army CPE Center or a civilian setting accredited by the Association of Clinical Pastoral Education, and completion of the Combat Medical Ministry Course (CMM) as taught by AMEDD Center & School, Department of Pastoral Ministry Training.
  - c. Restrictions. For use with Chaplain Branch 56A AOC only.

## 7S application process

- a. If you have already completed one unit of CPE prior to attending the CMM Course, turn in a certified transcript at in-processing. You will receive your orders for awarding the SI at graduation.
- b. If you complete one unit of CPE after attending the CMM Course, mail a certified transcript to the following address:
