

FY16 CLINICAL PASTORAL EDUCATION (CPE) SUPERVISORY EDUCATION STUDENT READINESS COMMITTEE

Supervisory Education Student Readiness Committee will convene on or about 21-23 JAN 2016, in San Antonio, Texas; to consider chaplain selection for training as Army ACPE Supervisors for FY16. Individuals who meet the eligibility requirements and pass initial screening will be considered. The eligibility criteria for the CPE Supervisory Education Student (SES/7R Trainer) Program are as follows:

1. CPT-P or MAJ with less than 15 years (180 months) of Active Federal Service as of the convening date of the board.
2. Completed the Chaplains Captain Career Course and Intermediate Level Education (ILE), or able to complete ILE within one year of selection.
3. A member of, or able to meet membership requirements in, the Association for Clinical Pastoral Education (ACPE) prior to the start of the Chaplain CPE SES training program.
4. Have successfully completed four Units of CPE in an accredited training center.
5. *Have fulfilled the three year CPE utilization requirement.*

Instructions

Each candidate's packet will include:

1. A signed memorandum by the applicant requesting SES training
2. A completed application form: "US Army Application for Clinical Pastoral Education 5G-CPE/SIT-7R Trainer Program." The application can be secured through the following hyperlink: <http://www.cs.amedd.army.mil/portlet.aspx?id=dca06bf7-3a2f-4845-b6da-f1f99412f0c8>
3. Current Officer Record Brief (in color).
4. A 5-8 page, double-spaced, Times New Roman, 12 font, biographical sketch of the applicant's life and spiritual journey. Include personal development, family background, educational and vocational history, religious development, and CPE experience
5. A 5-8 page essay describing the applicant's theological, educational and methodological understanding of Clinical Pastoral Education
6. A 5-8 page paper describing the candidate's strengths and weaknesses as a potential CPE supervisor and the motivation for entering training
7. Clinical Materials: Evidence of clinical pastoral practice that includes a recent verbatim of pastoral practice and other materials or supporting documents
8. Copies of all previous Clinical Pastoral Education Supervisor Evaluations (Student and Supervisor).
9. Association of Clinical Pastoral Education Transcript Verification Form (Contact ACPE for a copy of your transcript: www.acpe.edu or call (404) 320-1472). Provide them the following information, where you trained, when you trained and your training supervisor. For a nominal fee (\$ 25.00) they will send you an official transcript for inclusion in your packet. Remember to bring a hard copy with you for the interview process.
10. The applicants will submit, NLT 4 December, digital copies of all documents and secure with them a backup CD of requisite documents.
